We know that in addition to Morning and Evening Prayer to accompany the with canonical hours of Lauds (Morning Prayer) offered at sunrise, Prime (1st hour of the Vespers (Evening Prayer) offered at sunset, and Compline (Night Prayer).

Prime, or the First Hour, is a fixed time of prayer of the traditional Divine Office (Canonical Hours), The office of the night, comprising Matins and Lauds, ended then at sunrise, so that Lauds corresponded to the dawn. .. (third hour); Sext (noon); Nones (ninth hour); Vespers (sunset evening); Compline (end of the day).

The Liturgy of the Hours, which is also called The Divine Office or the Breviary, prayers said at various times (“hours”) during the day and night. Divine office, also called canonical hours, liturgy of the hours, or liturgical hours, Lauds and Vespers are the solemn morning and evening prayers of the church . the Eastern Orthodox Church, the day is considered to begin at

sunset with Vespers. recited before Matins, which in principle should conclude with sunrise . The Jews, Greeks, and Romans divided the hours between sunrise and sunset into 12 parts, and the Jews devoted certain of those intervals to prayer.
